



Women Get a Viagra

The problem of sexual dysfunction among [women](#) might be history, if trials conducted by Bayer [Pharmaceuticals](#) and Endoceutics come out to be successful. [The Company](#), Bayer Pharmaceuticals have already [pumped](#) in \$300million into the compound. Endoceutics claims it to be the answer to sexual dysfunction in women.
